

**ORDINANCE NO. 68-2016**

**INTRODUCED BY: Mayor Ann Marie Donegan**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 07-2016 WHICH ESTABLISHED A COMPREHENSIVE GRID SCHEDULE OF NON-UNION POSITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT AND RANGES OF PAY FOR SUCH POSITIONS, BY SUPPLEMENTING THE GRID SCHEDULE WITH TWO ADDITIONAL FULL TIME POSITIONS OF PROPERTY MAINTENANCE INSPECTOR AND SECRETARY**

**WHEREAS**, Council has previously adopted 07-2016 which established a comprehensive personnel ordinance for wages and compensation for non-union positions of employment in the City which, at Section 1 therein, established a comprehensive personnel grid schedule for non-union full time positions and part time positions in the City (excluding elected officials); and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 07-2016 establishes the terms for various benefits for qualifying employees as provided therein; and

**WHEREAS**, the operations of the City justify and require the establishment of the full time positions of a full time Property Maintenance Inspector and a full time Secretary; and

**WHEREAS**, it is appropriate to establish such positions in the comprehensive personnel ordinance identifying these positions and the range of pay therefor in the comprehensive non-union personnel grid schedule. Now therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** That Section 1 of Ordinance 07-2016 (a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference for information purposes) is hereby amended to supplement the grid schedule with the following full time positions and respective range of compensation:

<b>Position Full Time</b>	<b>Range of Compensation</b>
Property Maintenance Inspector	\$33,000 - \$46,000
Secretary/Clerk	\$29,000 - \$42,000

**SECTION 2.** That in all other respects, the provisions of Ordinance 07-2016 as adopted by Council on March 22, 2016 shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 3.** That all prior legislation inconsistent with this Ordinance in whole or in part is hereby repealed to the extent necessary to avoid conflict with this legislation.

**SECTION 4.** The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law, but retroactive to January 1, 2017.
