

**RESOLUTION NO. 27-2017**

**INTRODUCED BY: Mayor Ann Marie Donegan and Council as a Whole**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS UNDER THE STATE PURCHASING CONTRACT PROGRAM FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) POLICE VEHICLES AND RELATED EQUIPMENT, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the effective and efficient operation of the city's police department requires periodic replacement of police cruiser vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to acquire two (2) new police cruiser vehicles for the police department and to sell or trade one old police vehicle and to transfer another older police vehicle to the city's service department for service department use; and

**WHEREAS**, it is appropriate in the planning for replacement vehicles in the police department that one (1) new police cruiser vehicle be immediately acquired and that a second vehicle be acquired in the Fall, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, police cruiser vehicles (with related equipment) are available for purchase through the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, State Purchasing Contract program. Now therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into contracts, under the State Purchasing Contract program, for the purchase of two (2) police cruiser vehicles and related equipment, one (1) vehicle to be purchased immediately and one (1) vehicle to be purchased in the Fall 2017, all in accordance with the State Purchasing Contract Program which does not require advertising and bidding all in accordance with law and with a state contract approved vendor in an amount not to exceed \_\_\_\_\_ per vehicle.

**SECTION 2.** That one (1) old police vehicle no longer needed for municipal purposes be disposed of by trade-in, if available or by sale on govdeals.com, and the proceeds thereof be used to defray the costs of the new vehicles.

**SECTION 3.** That the funds necessary to acquire the aforesaid vehicles are hereby appropriated for the same and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to pay out such funds as called for hereinabove.

**SECTION 4.** The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took

place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 5.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure so that a contract may be entered into without delay in order to continue with the effective operations of the City for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Olmsted Falls and shall take effect immediately upon passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
