

ORDINANCE NO. 10-2018

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING PAULA ACCORDINO AS DIRECTOR OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FOR THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION, AND REPEALING ALL LEGISLATION INCONSISTENT HERewith AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Paula Accordino possesses various skill, experience and expertise in the field of economic development, communications and public relations to serve as the city's Director of Economic Development; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to appoint Ms. Accordino to serve on a permanent full-time basis as the Director of Economic Development for the City. Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. This Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of Paula Accordino as the Director of Economic Development for the City effective January 2, 2018 and retroactive thereto.

SECTION 2. The duties of the Director of Economic Development are identified in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, as set out in Chapter 234 of the Codified Ordinances, except that said position shall be full time with no fringe benefits (except required OPERS and Medicare by employer and employee). In Ordinance 10-2017 Council set rates of compensation in a range of \$45,000 to \$65,000 for Economic Development Director and as such, the compensation for the Economic Development Director shall be Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000.00) per annum.

SECTION 3. All prior legislation inconsistent with this legislation, in whole or in part, is hereby repealed to the extent necessary to avoid conflict with this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Olmsted Falls for the reason that Paula Accordino has been providing such services to the City since January 2, 2018 for which compensation is to be provided. Upon passage by the affirmative vote of no less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval

by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law, this Ordinance shall take effect and be retroactively applied from January 1, 2018 and thereafter.
