

RESOLUTION NO. 25-2018

INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR JAMES GRAVEN AND COUNCIL AS A WHOLE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FROM THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS FOR A SENIOR SERVICES PROJECT TO BE CONSIDERED BY THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY DIVISION OF SENIOR AND ADULT SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019 FOR COMMUNITY SOCIAL SERVICES PROGRAM, AND IF AWARDED, ACCEPTING SUCH GRANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City has been advised by the Division of Senior and Adult Services for the County of Cuyahoga that it is eligible to participate in a competitive application process for awarding of a community social services program; and

WHEREAS, the city is permitted to submit one application, with the total amount of the request not exceeding \$25,000; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined it is in the best interests of the community to apply for said grant funds for the expansion of mental and physical fitness and innovative programs and services offered in addition to the traditional programming that will effectively engage these residents who might not otherwise participate in programming. Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to submit a Senior Center Innovation Programming grant proposal for funding through the Division of Senior and Adult Services in the County of Cuyahoga, and if approved, hereby accepts said grant in accordance with the terms of the Grant Program.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Olmsted Falls for the further reason that the deadline for the submission of the Grant Application is June 1,

2018. Therefore, this Resolution shall therefore take effect immediately upon the passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor, or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law, whichever is later.
