

ORDINANCE NO. 38-2018

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 10-2017 WHICH ESTABLISHED A COMPREHENSIVE GRID SCHEDULE OF NON-UNION POSITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT AND RANGES OF PAY FOR SUCH POSITIONS, WITH THE ADDITION OF A PART TIME POSITION OF BUILDING ADMINISTRATOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has previously adopted 10-2017 which established a comprehensive personnel ordinance for wages and compensation for non-union positions of employment in the City which, at Section 1 therein, established a comprehensive personnel grid schedule for non-union full time positions and part time positions in the City (excluding elected officials); and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 10-2017 establishes the terms for various benefits for qualifying employees as provided therein; and

WHEREAS, the City’s contract with Safebuilt for the inspection of related building projects is terminating on July 12, 2018, and the part time position of Building Administrator is necessary to fulfill related residential building projects, including commercial plumbing and electrical inspections through a qualified building administrator; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to establish this additional position in the comprehensive personnel ordinance and the range of pay therefor in the comprehensive non-union personnel grid schedule. Now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance 10-2017 (a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein by reference for information purposes) is hereby amended to supplement the grid schedule with the following full time positions and respective range of compensation:

Position Full Time	Range of Compensation
Building Administrator	\$40.00 - \$50.00 – per hour

SECTION 2. That in all other respects, the provisions of Ordinance 10-2017 as adopted by Council on March 14, 2017 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That all prior legislation inconsistent with this Ordinance in whole or in part is hereby repealed to the extent necessary to avoid conflict with this legislation.
