

ORDINANCE NO. 45-2018

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT PROPOSAL TO THE MEMBER COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM (MCIP) OF THE NORTHEAST OHIO REGIONAL SEWER DISTRICT (NEORS) IN THE SUM OF \$175,000.00 FOR THE METROPOLITAN-HOLTON DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (NEORS) maintains a Member Community Infrastructure Program (MCIP) for which member communities may apply for grant funding for use in construction projects addressing drainage issues; and

WHEREAS, flooding and drainage issues are present in various sections of the city of Olmsted Falls, and City Administration and City Council deem it appropriate to seek funding for such issues; and

WHEREAS, the city of Olmsted Falls has submitted an application request on or about June 14, 2018 for \$175,000 for the Metropolitan-Holton Drainage Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, additional funding for this project is available from the Community Cost Share Fund of NEORS for the remaining 50% of the costs for said project. Now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. City Council adopts and ratifies the submittal of an application to NEORS Member Community Infrastructure Program (MCIP) for funding in the sum of One Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$175,000) for the Metropolitan-Holton Drainage Improvement Project, copy of said application is attached as Exhibit "A."

SECTION 2. Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Olmsted Falls for the further reason that applications are currently under review by NEORS and time is of the essence for legislative approval of this application.

Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council, and signature by the Mayor, or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
