

RESOLUTION NO. 32-2020

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS TO PARTICIPATE IN A FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT FOR 2020, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING AN AMBU-STAT SYSTEM FOR DECONTAMINATION OF EQUIPMENT, AND ACCEPTING SAID FUNDS IF AWARDED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Olmsted Falls desires to participate in the 2020 fiscal year FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant, and has submitted an application for the purpose of purchasing an Ambu-Stat System, an aerolizer to decontaminate living quarters and fire equipment; and

WHEREAS, said application, attached as Exhibit "A", was submitted by the City on May 15, 2020 provides for a grant of Three Thousand Eighty-Six Dollars (\$3,086.00) at a cost to the city of One Fifty-Four Dollars and 33/100 (\$154.33); and

WHEREAS, City Council deems it in the best interest of the City to ratify the submission of the aforesaid application. Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The application to the 2020 fiscal year FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant, submitted May 15, 2020, is hereby ratified and the Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to accept said funds, if awarded, on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Olmsted Falls for the reason that the Application authorized herein must be submitted during the application process. Therefore, this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five members elected to Council, and signature by the Mayor, or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
