AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR POLICE CHIEF TO DONATE CERTAIN OBSOLETE EQUIPMENT IN THE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT NO LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY LOCAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES, TO THE OHIO SMALL POLICE DEPARTMENT ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, certain items of obsolete equipment in the City Police Department are of no utility to the Department, are obsolete and of no municipal purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Small Police Department Association has solicited donations from other cities in Ohio for obsolete equipment that may be of use by the Ohio Small Police Department Association. Now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. That those items of obsolete equipment identified on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein are found to be of no further utility to the City and have little or no financial value.

SECTION 2. That the donation of said items identified on Exhibit "A" is hereby authorized to be made by the Mayor and/or Police Chief to the Ohio Small Police Department Association and that the sale of the same is therefore not required.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
