

RESOLUTION NO. 54-2020

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A THREE YEAR MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH BLUE TECHNOLOGIES SMART SOLUTIONS LLC, FOR COMPREHENSIVE MANAGED SUPPORT SERVICES FOR THE CITY'S COMPUTER SYSTEM, INCLUDING DESKTOP, SERVER AND MISCELLANEOUS NETWORK SUPPORT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to enter into a contract for comprehensive managed support services for the city's computer system with an authorized entity capable of performing such services; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to update and upgrade software licensing and security measures for the City's computer system including desktops, laptops and servers; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the administration that Blue Technologies Smart Solutions, LLC. be contracted to perform said services for a three (3) year term, 2021-2023; and

WHEREAS, Council hereby accepts the recommendation that Blue Technologies Smart Solutions, LLC. is the best entity to perform said services. Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is herein authorized to enter into a three year maintenance agreement 2021-2023 with Blue Technologies Smart Solutions, LLC for comprehensive managed support services for the City's computer system, including desktop, server and miscellaneous network support, at a monthly cost of Two Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Eight Dollars and 75/100 (\$2,998.75), and a one-time onboarding fee of Five Thousand One Hundred Seventy-Eight Dollars and 75/100 (\$5,178.75), based generally upon its proposal dated November 25, 2020, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. This agreement shall be in effect on January 1, 2021, and shall continue until terminated pursuant to its terms.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Olmsted Falls in order to have the computer support services continue without interruption. It shall therefore
