

Olmsted Falls Citizen of the Year

Each year, Olmsted Falls honors one of its residents whose service and dedication exhibits a significant contribution to our community. The recipient(s) must demonstrate an outstanding commitment and dedication to the betterment of everyday life in Olmsted Falls.

Eligibility Requirements:

A Nominee must:

- Be a current resident of Olmsted Falls for a period of at least 12 months.
- Have not received the award in the past.
- Elected officials and Parks and Recreation Board members are excluded from nomination.

Selection Qualifications:

A Nominee should:

- Have exemplified above average volunteer and/or philanthropic contributions to the City.
- Consistently demonstrate distinguished volunteer service providing significant value to the community. Examples include but are not limited to: Civic Organizations; School Activities; Recreation; Church; Community Events; Special volunteer service to the community
- Have not received any payment for the volunteer activity for which the award is being considered.

OR

Have voluntarily performed duties related to their paid employment significantly beyond what is expected of the person holding that position and not substantially as a result of their primary employment.

The City of Olmsted Falls **Parks and Recreation Board** will review each nomination submitted for consideration and select the winner based on the qualifications and content presented on the nomination form. The Board reserves the right to validate all information presented.

NOTES:

- The Citizen of the Year winner will be announced at the Falls Day in the Park community event.
- It is the intent of the Parks and Recreation Board of the City of Olmsted Falls to have the name of the award recipient published and information relating to the nomination made public.
- The identity of the award recipient is kept confidential until the ceremony at Falls Day in the Park.
- It is assumed that the nominee has agreed to stand for the nomination and will agree to participate in events and publicity related to the Citizen of the Year award.
- The recipient must be able to uphold the dignity of the award and be capable of performing some duties if called upon.
