Rules and regulations for obtaining a solicitors permit in the City of Olmsted Falls

Please be advised that your certificate of solicitation may be denied or revoked for the following reasons:

- The applicant has made a false, misleading or deceptive statement in providing the information required.
- The applicant has been convicted of a felony violation or misdemeanor violation involving moral turpitude during the last five (5) years.
- The applicant has not supplied all the requested information.

All Certificates of Solicitation are subject to the following restrictions:

- All circulars, samples or other matter shall be handed to an occupant of the property or left in a secure place on the premises.
- No persons subject to the provisions of this chapter shall canvass or solicit, except between the hours of 9:00 am and 9:00 pm.
- No canvasser or solicitor shall enter or attempt to enter the house of apartment of any resident in the city without an EXPRESS invitation from the occupant of the house or apartment.
- No canvasser or solicitor shall engage in or transact any type of business or solicitation other than that specified in the permit application.
- Upon completion of the solicitation period all permit cards will be returned to the issuing department.

All persons requesting to hold a solicitor permit must have the following items submitted to The Olmsted Falls Police Department BEFORE a permit will be issued:

- A BCI and/or a FBI background check completed by an outside company
- Photo copy of your driver's license or state ID card
- Completed solicitors permit application

What is the difference between the BCI and the FBI fingerprint scans?

A BCI fingerprint searches only the state of Ohio. The FBI is a national database search. You can get either a BCI, FBI or both depending on the reason for the fingerprinting. Having both the BCI and the FBI searches completed are especially important for candidates who have lived in another state in the past 5 years or more. A crime could have been committed in another state and if only the state of Ohio is searched, those criminal records could be missed.
