Dear Olmsted Falls Residents:

The City of Olmsted Falls wishes to provide information to electric customers who are enrolled in NOPEC's Electric Aggregation Program regarding NOPEC'S current pricing.

New NOPEC electric rates were recently released, and they are higher than rates charged by the utility. NOPEC's current month Standard Program Price per kilowatt hour is \$0.12. The utility's price to compare for August is \$0.06786, on Apples to Apples Comparison Chart (Energy Choice Ohio - Electric). Numerous factors are causing electric rate increases such as the timing of electricity auctions by FirstEnergy, energy supply issues, and worldwide demand. Residents should call **855-667-3201** for details. This difference will continue until next year when the utility's price is expected to adjust to the current market and will likely increase. Customers who opt-out will then be eligible to rejoin NOPEC's aggregation when the markets normalize.

In addition, residents can register at PUCO to be on a "Do Not Aggregate List". See the link below. This link also describes the government aggregation program and what cities are allowed to do. Residents can be permanently removed from being a part of this program, which is currently NOPEC in Olmsted Falls.
